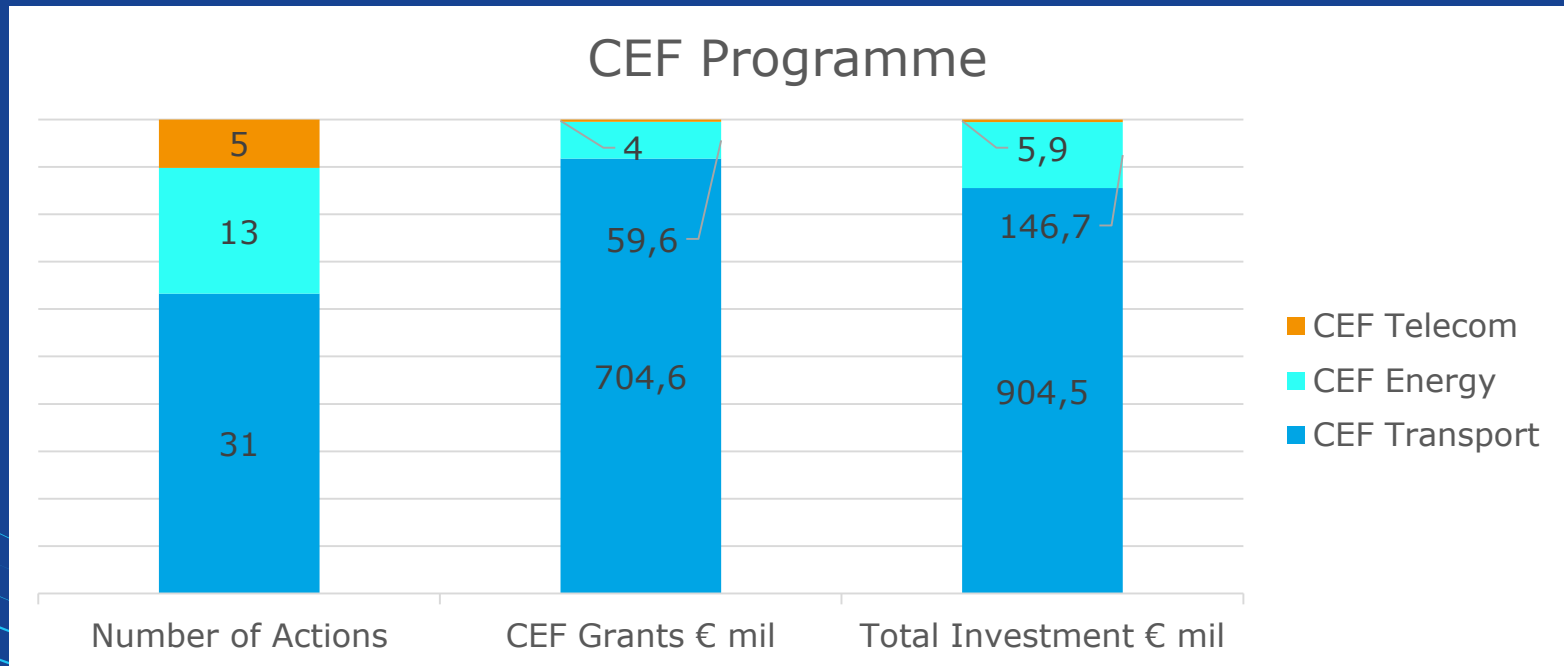

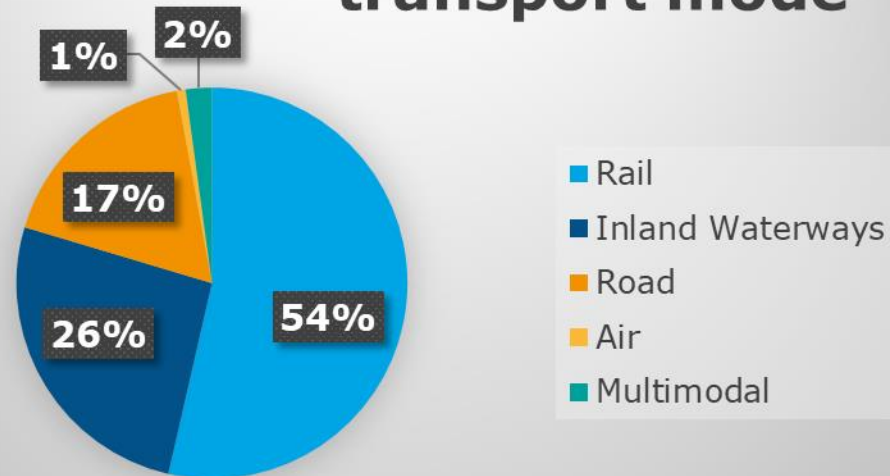
€ 704,6 million of CEF Grants:

- € 704,5 million allocated to the Cohesion envelope
- Dedicated cohesion envelope under CEF Transport for Slovakia – around € 740 million- 95% consumption

2014-2018 calls (excluding ongoing call CEF Transport 2018) Slovakian applicants:

- 48 eligible proposals submitted
- 34 projects selected

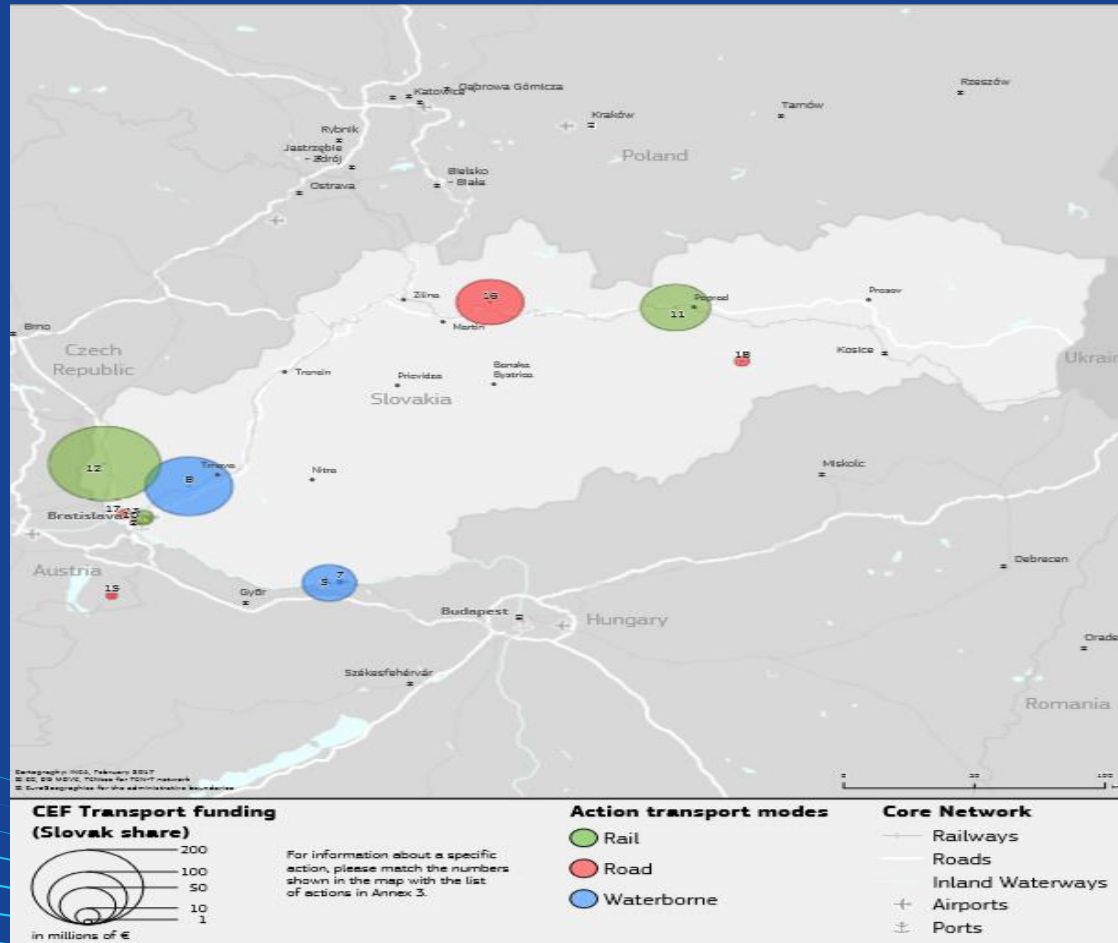



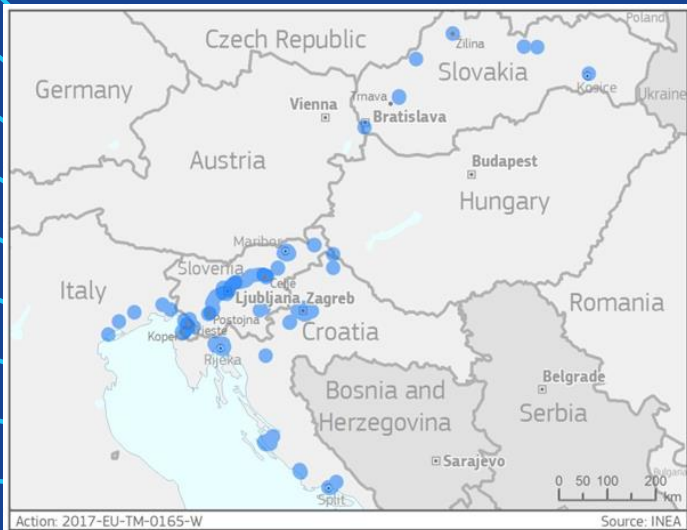
